### Rector's ramblings

February the shortest of months, yet there is much to look forward to from Valentines day to Shrove Tuesday and Ash Wednesday (see over the page for details of events and services).

On the 1<sup>st</sup> we will be marking the feast of the Presentation of Christ in the temple In the temple

Simeon and Anna recognised and received the Messiah. Both had waited decades for this moment and were elderly when they met Jesus, showing that age is not a barrier to serving God.



**Challenge:** Their dedication to worship, fasting, and prayer serves as an example of lifelong devotion, relevant to all generations.

- They were able to recognize the Saviour in a humble baby because they were guided by the Holy Spirit and attuned to God's presence.  
**Challenge:** That we might be open to seeing God at work in unexpected places and in everyday life.
- After seeing Jesus, Anna immediately began to "speak of him to all who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem".  
**Challenge:** to share personal testimony and proclaim the message of salvation to others.
- Simeon's declaration, "my eyes have seen your salvation," expresses a deep sense of peace and fulfilment after a lifetime of seeking God.
- **Their story assures us that in Jesus, we can find genuine soul satisfaction and true consolation.**

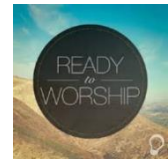
