

Friday 20th February 2026 2:30pm
Session 1 – Introducing the Bible

The Bible claims to be inspired by God and there's good reason to believe it. The Bible is the world's bestselling book. Inside its cover, we find an ancient library, which forms one big story with a powerful message for today. In this session, we focus on the Bible as a story, book and revelation.

Session 2 – Genesis: The Story Begins
Genesis touches on some of the most fundamental questions of our existence. By exploring the dramatic events of Genesis, we discover how the first book of the Bible sets up the whole story. In this session, we explore the ancient book of Genesis, which sets up the whole story of the Bible. It still provides the best explanation for all the beauty and tragedy in our world.

	<p>Friday 6th March 2026 2:30pm</p> <p>Session 3 – Exodus: The Story of Freedom</p> <p>God calls Moses and, through miraculous events, rescues his people from slavery in Egypt to lead them into the Promised Land. Exodus points forward to Jesus, who promises true freedom for us. In this session, we explore the dramatic events of Exodus, and the story of God's people as they escape from Egypt and learn to trust God on their journey to the promised land.</p>
	<p>Friday 13th March 2026 2:30pm</p> <p>Session 4 – Kings: The Story of Power</p> <p>God chose leaders to guide the people of Israel – judges such as Samson and Deborah, and kings such as David and Solomon. Despite God's help, they didn't always rule wisely. In this session we focus on the story of the judges and kings and the theme of power.</p>
	<p>Friday 20th March 2026 2:30pm</p> <p>Session 5 – Exile: The Story of Loss</p> <p>Israel experienced a dark period of division, defeat and deportation. However, God raised up prophets who promised that the best was yet to come. In this session, we explore the division of the kingdom, the role of the prophets and the trauma of exile.</p>
	<p>Friday 27th March 2026 2:30pm</p> <p>Session 6 – Jesus: The Story of Rescue</p> <p>The Gospels capture the extraordinary life of Jesus – Messiah, Saviour and Lord. Now this same Jesus invites us to follow him. In this session, we focus on the life, death and resurrection of Jesus – as told in the four Gospels.</p>

Session 7 – Acts: The Story of Mission

This session starts with the book of Acts, exploring the mission of the early Church. The book of Acts captures the explosive growth of early Christianity. This story continues today as we share the good news of Jesus with our world.



Friday 17th April 2026 2:30pm

Session 8 – Revelation: The Story Completed

The Bible concludes with stunning visions of our world perfectly restored. This hope inspires us to share God's love and truth until we finally arrive home. In this session, we focus on the final book of the Bible and discover how Revelation is still relevant for our lives today.
